Please call **352-732-3008** to obtain an appointment for the Outreach Event (ONLY). WALK-INS ARE NOT ACCEPTED. You cannot apply online. The following documents are **REQUIRED** to apply for Electric Bill Assistance during the CFCAA outreach.

*(If you are missing any documents you may not be seen!!!)*

**\*\*\*READ CAREFULLY AND FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS EXACTLY\*\*\***

1. Photo ID (no more than one year expired) for all household members.
2. Social Security Cards (or equivalent documentation of SS number) for all household members.
3. ID or birth certificate to document the age of any household member 60 years and older or 5 years and under.
4. Two most recent electric bills for your residence.
  - If service is turned off, bring a letter from the utility company showing the current amount needed to restore service. The letter must be signed, dated, and show the service address.
5. If you receive any kind of housing assistance (HUD or Section 8), bring one of the following documents:
  - Shelter Verification Form obtained from the housing authority showing current amount of utility check for the last two months or showing zero utility check if you don't get one.
  - Verification of Utility Allowance Form (obtained from the Levy County Office) to be completed by the housing authority.
6. ALL household Income for the **last 30 days**, including anything received on the day of the *outreach*. Sources of Income: Wages, Self-employment, Social Security/SSI/SSD/SSA (2017 Award Letter), TANF, Retirement/Pension (2017 Benefit Letter), VA benefits, Child Support, Unemployment, Worker's Comp, Financial Aid/Educational Assistance, and/or Cash Assistance.
7. Food Stamps Benefit Letter showing amount received in March 2017.

**NOTE: After meeting with a LIHEAP Specialist, you may be required to provide additional information or documents as determined by your individual situation.**
